Urban networks of football fields and international sports and cultural events, urban retail networks, urban networks of roads and other transport routes, urban communal infrastructure networks, urban service networks, green systems and surfaces ...

Are these only modern names for well known spatial phenomena, processes or activities, typical for all urban areas throughout history? Have we just recently in times of information and communication, as well as technological awakening rediscovered something, that we had already known, but somehow didn't see as an essential topic for discussion? Not only on the level of particular cities, but all towns, all nations across all continents.
